Quigley Manor, Bethany Cochrane's supportive living residence, is located inside of Bethany Cochrane. Bethany Cochrane has been part of the community of Cochrane for over 25 years. We have developed great relationships with local schools, churches and community groups.

Most of our staff are long-time Bethany employees and Cochrane locals who live, work, and raise their families in the community they serve. They understand the importance of building community in a supportive environment. A prime example is that Bethany Cochrane connects with a local school to offer the Grandparent program. This program provides students a platform to hear about our residents' life stories and learnings while the students give our residents assistance participating in activities.

We also maintain positive connections with local health services, dentists, podiatrists and ophthalmologists to ensure quality professional care is available to our residents.



Quigley Manor offers 38 supportive living suites in both private and semi-private room settings.

Quigley Manor strives to meet the needs of the whole person — body, mind and spirit — by promoting the values of choice, quality of life, independence and community. Grounded by faith and strong values, we provide services to foster well-being for the physical, spiritual and emotional needs.

| More than just Giving Health Care |

One of the greatest advantages of supportive living is the security of knowing that assistance is only a moment away.

At Quigley Manor, our recreation attendant, volunteer service coordinator, supportive living manager, administrator and supporting staff are committed to making a profound difference in the lives of our residents on a daily basis.

In conjunction with Philips Lifeline, we provide a 24-hour personal response system that allows more than 5,000 clients throughout Alberta to call for assistance from highly trained, caring response associates with the simple touch of a button, 365 days a year. Philips Lifeline is included in the monthly rent of Quigley Manor.

We work collaboratively with Home Care* staff from Alberta Health Services so that they can assess ongoing care requirements and assign care plans to best meet our residents' needs.

Home Care provides nursing services seven days a week. These services include scheduled medication assistance, personal care, bathing assistance and referrals to specialty support services such as dietitians, home support workers, licensed practical nurses (LPNs), occupational therapists (OTs), physical therapists (PTs), registered nurses (RNs), respiratory therapists (RTs), social workers and speech-language pathologists.

Residents have access to all common areas including the library for some quiet reading; the bright art & crafts room to stimulate creativity. Staying in the covered seating areas in the gazebo for the summer afternoon tea with fellow residents is definitely a favourite. The auditorium is used for dining and other social events.

Surface parking is available for those residents who drive their own vehicle.

| Activities |

The ability to stay active in the community is one of the best part about living at Quigley Manor. Our recreation department creates a full recreation calendar every month to make sure our residents are given the opportunity to participate in a variety of activities.

The common areas allow for activities such as playing cards, reading in the library, sing-alongs, jigsaw puzzles, crafts or gardening.

A wheelchair accessible bus gives residents the opportunity for activities like excursions, theatre trips and other social events.

The Grandparent program with a local school offers periodic visits from the students. Residents and students participate in activities such as arts & crafts, nail painting, hand

massages, making ginger bread houses and other group games.

Other Amenities

The historic chapel, All Saints Anglican Chapel nestled alongside Bethany Cochrane has been a fixture in the community since 1892. The quaint chapel, which seats about 45, has changed locations three times in its lifespan and finally settled at Bethany Cochrane in 2004. The chapel has provided a spiritual retreat for the residents, staff, families and community members.
