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Our Outbreak Process

We have implemented a series of outbreak processes and protocols to help keep people safe. Please read our [statement](#) online for a summary of the steps we are taking.

Here's a brief overview:

- If any resident displays symptoms, they will receive immediate attention, a swab will be taken and the resident's family will be notified.
- Employees with confirmed cases of COVID-19 are self-isolating at home, at the direction of Alberta Health Services (AHS) and the Medical Officer of Health. They will not return to work until cleared by Public Health.
- Employees identified by the Medical Officer of Health who have been in close contact with a confirmed individual are at home, self-isolating as a standard precaution. They will not return to work until cleared by Public Health.

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While the news about vaccines is positive, we continue to implement our strong infection, prevention and control measures at our sites and follow all health orders as mandated by the province. Our employees and designated support/family persons will continue to follow strict safety protocols until further notice.

Designated family/support person (DFSP) visitation is restricted on Level 2 South (Southview), as it remains in outbreak. The MOH/CDC will determine when the outbreak can be lifted.

All other levels and Hillside Manor are no longer in outbreak. DFSP visitation is allowed and can be arranged via the Care Services Manager. However, we strongly advise DFSPs to limit their presence on site whenever possible. Minimizing the number of individuals entering our sites each day helps reduce the risk of further spread of the virus.

In the meantime, please continue to abide by our current visitor restrictions at Bethany Calgary. Thank you for your understanding and the sacrifices you are making in light of our public health measures.
