As part of the phased lifting of restrictions outlined in CMOH Order 36-2021, there are still a few preventative measures that will be in place until further notice. We ask that you carefully review these guidelines prior to coming on site.

Restrictions remaining in place:

- Health Assessment Screening and continuous masking for staff, volunteers and service providers
- Visiting persons are required to wear a mask continuously in common areas and will be screened upon entry
- Unvaccinated visiting persons (including children under 12) are strongly encouraged to wear a mask even in resident room/private areas

Upon declaration of an outbreak, we continue to follow strict outbreak protocols and implement select quarantine/isolation requirements when needed. We will update impacted residents and families as required.

Current units in declared outbreak and those recently lifted:
There are 3 active cases; Bethany CollegeSide is in outbreak.

PLEASE NOTE: The Medical Officer of Health (MOH) has directed that visitation to Bethany CollegeSide (all houses/site-wide) is to be restricted to designated visitors only. Designated visitors are asked to wear their face mask continuously, including in the privacy of a resident's room.

These directives are in place for the duration of the outbreak.

Thank you for your understanding and the sacrifices you are making in light of our public health measures. Your safety, as well as the safety and wellbeing of your family, the residents and staff, remains our top priority.

Our Outbreak Process

We have implemented a series of outbreak processes and protocols to help keep people safe. Please read our [statement](#) online for a summary of the steps we are taking.

Here's a brief overview:

- If any resident displays symptoms, they will receive immediate attention, a swab will be taken and the resident's family will be notified.
- Employees with confirmed cases of COVID-19 are self-isolating at home, at the direction of Alberta Health Services (AHS) and the Medical Officer of Health. They will not return to work until cleared by Public Health.
- Employees identified by the Medical Officer of Health who have been in close contact with a confirmed individual are at home, self-isolating as a standard precaution. They will not return to work until cleared by Public Health.
